

Sample of School Day Program

7:00-8:00am	Table activities such as games, coloring and other quiet morning activities
7:00-8:00am	Freestyle* snack is offered all morning until 7:50am.
8:00-8:05am	Children clean up activity areas, all schools prepare for walk
3:00-3:15pm	Students are picked up from Westbrook
3:05-3:20pm	Students are picked up from St. Boniface
3:19-3:30pm	Students are picked up from St. Stanislaus and Greenfield
3:20-5:15pm	Child-directed activities. This includes options such as: snack (until 4:00), outside play, centers, programmed or planned activities, themed experiences.
<small>**Most activities are divided between 1-3 & 4-6. Programming for older grade levels will include things like Billiards and Fozzball.</small>	
5:15-6:00pm	Clean-up and home time.

*Freestyle snack is when children are able to serve their own plate of snack. The staff will set out bowls, plates, napkins and the snack. There will be a piece of paper instructing the children to take a certain number of the food items that are available. (Ie - please take 3 pieces of veggies, 2 pieces of fruit and 1 bun). If we have hot items for snack, such as soup, hot cereal or toast, then the staff will serve the snack to the children for safety purposes.

Note: On early Thursdays, programming begins as soon as children arrive after dismissal as school dismissal times are not always the same. Children eat lunch upon arrival, and are given additional choice in activities. Certain activities, such as ice skating which requires cold weather, is often an additional choice at this time and as more students arrive at the center, early Thursday students then have an option to come in for snack, or an indoor activity. Other Thursday activities can include the use of technology (video camera for example), dance, baking club, craft club, scrap booking, or combining multiple centers for larger group activities.

Sample of Non-School Day Program

7:00-8:15am	Table activities such as games, coloring, manipulative room (Lego) and other building structures, and other quiet morning activities
8:00-11:30am	Snack is offered (until 9). There is also movement between outdoor playtime, centers, craft, child-directed experiences and on certain non-school days a field trip will be planned during this time.

(Children should be dropped off at the center no later than 8:45am on Field Trip days, to ensure everyone is ready (wearing sunscreen, proper attire, etc.) by 9am).

11:00-1:00pm

Clean up and Lunchtime

12:30-1:00pm

Choice Quiet/fine motor activities

1:00-5:30pm

Themed Week Activities or organized outdoor/sport time, snack is offered (2:30-3:30), free play time and movement between centers, craft depending on requests of children. During some non-school days, a field trip may be planned during this time.

5:15-6:00pm

Clean up and home time

*These times are flexible and based on the needs and requests of the children. Time frames are only generalizations for the planning of the day and not permanently set.
